THE SILVER ARROW for the highest score recorded by the sex opposite to that which wins the Golden Arrow; the winner to be known as the Lieutenant of Sherwood Forest.

THE BRONZE ARROW for the runner-up, provided he or she is not the winner of the Silver Arrow

THE MACKNESS QUIVER for the highest score recorded by a Nottinghamshire gentleman

THE MAID MARION CUP for the highest score recorded by a Nottinghamshire Lady.

THE ROBIN HOOD TROPHY for the highest score recorded by an archer of either sex who has never won a trophy, medal or prize (on pure score) at an open tournament.

SIX BATH AND WEST HORNS for the two highest scores, one lady & one gentleman, in 3 handicap groups.

THE STYGIAN AWARD for the highest number of blacks.

HIDDEN SCORE PRIZE

TEAM TROPHY .Team to consist of any 4 recurve archers from one club.

GOLDEN GOBLET. Highest scoring junior,

SILVER GOBLET. Highest scoring junior of opposite sex.

LONGBOW TROPHIES awarded for the highest scores recorded by both sexes.
