### **NOTES:**

- This Record Status shoot will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply; refusal to comply will be treated as a positive result. Parents/guardians of junior competitors must sign the entry form to signify their consent to drug testing
- GNAS dress code 307 will apply
- GNAS cards must be shown at registration
- Carbon arrows must be able to be found along their full length using a metal detector
