Silver Trophies for:

- 1st Club Team (4 archers, max 1 compound, must contain either 1 lady or junior)
- 1st Lady Recurve (Hereford round)
- 1st Gent Recurve (York round)
- 1st Gent Compound (York round)
- 1st Junior Recurve (Any Bristol round)
- Best Gold – The Pinhole Trophy (All rounds longest distance only)

Other trophies for longbow, junior compound etc. Medals according to entry

NOTES:

- Archers competing at this Record Status shoot will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply; refusal to comply will be treated as a positive result. Entries from archers under 18 must be signed by a parent/guardian (i.e. a person with parental responsibility) to signify their consent to their child being drug tested if approached – without this consent an entry cannot be accepted
- GNAS dress code 307 will apply
- GNAS cards must be shown at registration
- Carbon arrows must be able to be found along their full length using a metal detector
- In line with the GNAS Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, anybody wishing to take photographs at this event must register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival and provide proof of identity. No unauthorised photography will be permitted
- Juniors shooting senior rounds compete for senior trophies only.
